


## SOP FOR PLANNING & CONDUCTING RETEST EXAMS FOR SLOW/POOR LEARNER STUDENTS

- For Under Graduate Student:
- If the student will fail (Less than 50 %) or gets border line passing marks in the 1<sup>st</sup>& 2<sup>nd</sup> sessional exams, they will be considered as poor or slow learner students.
- Retests will be conducted with appropriate focus on the subject/topic in which
  the students are found to be slow/poor learners.
- To improve the writing skill and practice purpose of these students, they will
  ask to read about the questions asked in the exam & they will inform to write
  the answers for practice purpose.
- The students will ask to write a retest exam after 1<sup>st</sup>& 2<sup>nd</sup> sessional exam according to the given remedial teaching plan for slow learner.
- For Post Graduate Student: If the student will fail in the university exam, four retest exams will be conducted for them.
- Institute follows the guidelines given by MUHS.
- Question paper format for UG & PG student retest:

# SOP FOR PLANNING & CONDUCTING IMPROVEMENT EXAMS FORREPEATER STUDENTS

- For Under Graduate Student: If the student will fail in the university exam, two sessional exams (1st improvement & 2<sup>nd</sup> Improvement exams) will be conducted for repeater students.
- It will be compulsory for the repeater students to appear for these two exams otherwise their final internal assessment will not be signed by the respective HOD.
- Full set of the paper (MCQ, SAQ and LAQ) will be corrected by the examiner.
- For Sessional exam pattern, institute follows the guidelines given by MUHS.


