


### Policy Regarding Preventive Immunization Of Students, Teachers And Hospital Staff

Healthcare workers of MGVKBHDCH includes dental professionals and students, medical faculty, nurses, laboratory technicians, and administrative staff. Dental health care profession has the potential to expose the students and staff to infectious diseases, especially Hepatitis B which spreads through salivary or blood contamination and is a life threatening disease. At the same time, it can be prevented through proper vaccination. Immunizations substantially reduce susceptibility to these diseases as well as the potential for disease transmission to other dental health care providers and patients.

#### Immunisation Policy for students - Hepatitis B

Immunization is an essential part of the prevention and infection control programs at the college of dentistry.

As a matter of policy, our institution provides vaccination against Hepatitis B for all students who secure admission for BDS program in the institution. This vaccination is provided as early as possible after the admission into first year of BDS program.

For students taking admission in MDS program, we make sure that the student is vaccinated before joining.

College schedules Hepatitis B vaccination programme at start of first year BDS as a three-dose series (on a zero, one and six-month schedule) annually and provides vaccination of Hepatitis B to them for their safety to work in the clinical scenario in the institution.

## Immunisation Policy for students - Other communicable diseases

At the time of admission, a self-declaration is sought from all the students which include an immunisation history for Influenza (flu), Measles, Mumps, and Rubella, Varicella (chicken pox), Tetanus/Diphtheria.

Institution advises and instructs the students to get those vaccinations from family physicians if not done.

## Immunisation Policy for teachers and hospital staff

At the time of joining, a self-declaration is sought from all the teachers and hospital staff which include an immunisation history for Hepatitis B, Influenza (flu), Measles, Mumps, and Rubella, Varicella (chicken pox), Tetanus/Diphtheria.

Institution advises and instructs non vaccinated staff to get those vaccinations from family physicians before joining or receive the doses along with the first year BDS students' vaccination program.
