

3. Student Placement:

- a. The institute is fortunate to have a vast network of established alumni who are into active clinical practice. These alumni provide opportunities to our students for observation as well as placements at their clinics which help students learn many things like how to dress professionally, how to communicate with the patient, how to manage appointments, stock, finances besides learning the art of patient management, treatment modalities, handling various instruments and many more things. Eventually these students become confident about their skills and go on to establish their own successful practice. The college has a list of established alumni practicing in Nasik and other cities who provide observation and placement opportunities to our students. Various short-term courses are conducted at these clinics which students can get enrolled in to enhance their professional skills.
- b. The alumni advertise requirements of dental associate in their clinics on the college WhatsApp group created for job opportunities. Interested students can directly get in touch with prospective employers.
- c. The alumni settled abroad also provide opportunities to our students to work as dental assistants at their clinics as they prepare for their licensing exams. Dr Amol Kulkarni, our alumnus is Rwanda, Africa is willing to give internships to students willing to go to work there. He has already provided employment to one of our students at his clinic.
- d. The institute also has a large number of alumni who have moved into non-clinical fields like insurance, health analytics, hospital management, pharmacovigilance, content-writing, medical coding, clinical documentation specialist, etc. These students

provide leads regarding openings in their organizations and help in providing recommendation to our students thus helping in placements.

4. Student Exchanges:

- a. Our alumni spread across the world are ever-willing to extend a helping hand to our students going abroad for work or higher education. Our alumni have their presence in the US, Canada, UK, Scotland, Germany, Switzerland, Malaysia, Australia, New Zealand, Taiwan, UAE, Saudi Arabia, Rwanda to name a few countries. The international alumni WhatsApp group connects the students wishing to move abroad to the alumni already settled there. It makes a big difference to have someone hold your hand while you find your footing in a foreign land. These alumni provide authentic information about colleges, admission procedure, choosing courses, preparation for exams, licensing process, etc. and also provide opportunities for observation and employment. They also assist in securing admission to colleges, paper publication, etc. The information and mentoring are indeed invaluable and far more authentic than what is available online or what is provided by the counsellors.
- b. With the help of our alumnus, Dr Smita Nimbalkar, at School of Dentistry, IMU, Malaysia, our students got an opportunity to be part of an International Mobility Program. This gave the students an insight into critical thinking and problem-based learning and advanced concepts of dentistry at a global level.

5. Institutional Endowments:

a. The Alumni Association conducts many activities which contribute to the development of the institute and the holistic development of the students through a variety of educational programs and interactive lectures, career guidance sessions, discussions on alternate career options, lectures on preparation for competitive exams, continuing dental education programs, public and oral health awareness, forensic odontology, health research methodology, how to do systematic review, clinical audit and many more.

- b. The Alumni interview series is a series of interviews of established alumni conducted by our students to get to know about the journeys of these alumni, their struggles, their hard-work, their dedication and perseverance before they eventually succeeded.
- c. The Alumni Mentorship Congress that is organized every year is an effort to have about 7-8 alumni address the students on a particular theme every year. Students get a chance to meet these successful alumni in person, listen to their topic, interact and take guidance from them.
- d. Besides the theme of mentorship congress, alumni working in various fields are regularly invited to address the students so as to widen their horizons and provide the necessary impetus to the students to look beyond what is visible and aim to reach higher and higher.
- e. Four of the alumni of the institute settled abroad have agreed to join the institute as Adjunct Faculty in various dental departments. These faculty bring with them years of experience and a specialized skill set. They conduct at least one lecture/year, either physically or online. These sessions provide insight to the students on topics that are not part of the curriculum and give them a global perspective of dentistry.
- f. The Alumni of the college have donated medicinal plants for developing herbal garden at the institute. This will contribute to a greener campus, purification of environment and also help students to learn to identify these plants, understand their medicinal value and explore possibilities of using extracts of these plants against dental pathogens.
